By resolving 216 into prime factor,

2	216
2	108

	1

$$216 = 2 \times 2 \times 2 \times 3 \times 3 \times 3$$

By grouping the factors in triplets of equal factors, $216 = (2 \times 2 \times 2) \times (3 \times 3 \times 3)$

Here, 216 can be grouped into triplets of equal factors,

$$\therefore 216 = (2 \times 3)^3 = 6^3$$

Hence, 216 is cube of 6.
