



Q1. The cost of 1 dozen eggs is Rs. 36.

(a) What is the cost of 3 dozen eggs?

Ans. Cost of 1 dozen = Rs. 36

Cost of 3 dozen eggs =  $3 \times 36 = \text{Rs. } 108$

(b) What is the cost of 1 egg?

Ans. Cost of 12 eggs = Rs. 36

Cost of 1 egg =  $36 \div 12 = \text{Rs. } 3$

Q2. If the cost of 8kg oranges is Rs. 680, what will be the cost of 12kg oranges?

Solu. Cost of 8kg oranges = Rs. 680

Cost of 1kg oranges =  $680 \div 8 = \text{Rs. } 85$

Cost of 12 kg oranges =  $85 \times 12 = \text{Rs. } 1,020$

Q3. A bus can cover 160km in 4hours. How much distance can it cover in 9 hours if it moves at the same speed?

Solu. Distance cover in 4hours = 160km

Distance cover in 1hour =  $160 \div 4 = 40\text{km}$

Distance cover in 9hours =  $40 \times 9 = 360\text{km}$

Q4. If 8 workers can build a road in 6 days, how many days will 3 workers take to build the same road?

Ans. 8 workers = 6days

3 workers = ?

$8/3 \times 6 = 2.6 \times 6 = 16\text{days}$

Q5. 7 pumps working together can empty a tank in 30 mins. How long will it take to empty the tank if 15 such pumps are working together?

Ans. 7 pumps = 30mins

15 pumps = ?

$7/15 \times 30 = 0.46 \times 30 = 14$  minutes.

Q6. If 45 men can complete a work in 15 days. If 30 more men join them, how many days will they take to complete the work?

Ans. 45 men = 15 days

30 more men  $30 + 45 = 75 = ?$

$45/75 \times 15 = 0.6 \times 15 = 9$  days
