Amount left $=59,99,999-43,78,766=16,21,233$
(b) Light travels at a speed of $29,97,92,458$ meters per second. If a ray of light has already travelled 10,19,99,798 meters, how much distance is left for it to travel in that second?

Solu : Speed of light (per sec) $=\mathbf{2 9 , 9 7 , 9 2 , 4 5 8}$
Already travelled $=10,19,99,798$
Distance left $=\mathbf{2 9}, 97,92,458-10,19,99,798=19,77,92,660 \mathrm{~m}$
(c) A biscuit factory places an order for $10,34,567 \mathrm{~kg}$ of flour in a month. Out of this, $3,47,98,000 \mathrm{~g}$ is corn flour, $7,89,24,000 \mathrm{~g}$ is maize flour, $16,54,10,000 \mathrm{~g}$ is oat flour and the remaining is whole wheat flour. How much wheat flour does the biscuit factory order?

Solu : Total flour = 10,34,567 kg
Corn flour $=3,47,98,000 \mathrm{~g}$
Convert into $(\mathrm{kg})=3,47,98,000 \div 1000=34,798 \mathrm{~kg}$
Maize flour $=7,89,24,000 \mathrm{~g}$
Convert into $(\mathrm{kg})=\mathbf{7 , 8 9 , 2 4 , 0 0 0 \div 1 0 0 0 = 7 8 , 9 2 4 \mathrm { kg }}$
Oat flour $=16,54,10,000 \mathrm{~g}$
Convert into $(\mathrm{kg})=16,54,10,000 \div 1000=1,65,410 \mathrm{~kg}$
Total $=34,798+78,924+1,65,410=2,79,133$
Wheat flour $=10,34,567-2,79,133=7,55,434 \mathrm{~kg}$
