Q2. Four-fifths of Raghav's friends are wearing red shirts. What percentage of his friends are wearing red shirts?

Solu. Wearing red shirt = $\frac{4}{5}$

Percentage of wearing red shirt = $\frac{4}{5} \times 100 = 80\%$

Q3. The temperature of place A is 35 °C and the temperature of place B is 35 °F. Which place is hotter and by how much? Express the answer in °F.

Solu. Temperature of place A in °F = $(35 \times \frac{9}{5}) + 32 = 95$ °F

Place A is $95 - 35 = 60$ °F hotter than place B.

Q4. The temperature of a city during the day was 95 °F. It dropped by 5 °C in the evening. Write the temperature of the city in the evening in Celsius.

Solu. Temperature during day = 95 °F = $(95 - 32) \times \frac{5}{9} = 35$ °C

Temperature dropped = $35 - 5 = 30$ °C
