**Q.8 What are Clip Arts? Differentiate between Linking and Embedding an object.**

**Ans. Clip Arts –**

Clip art is a collection of pictures or images that can be imported into a document or another program. The images may be either raster graphics or vector graphics. Most clip art is royalty free, meaning you can use the images without paying royalties to the creators of the images.

**Difference –**Embedding an object in the media item places a copy of the original object (Word document, image file, etc.) into the database. When the original document/object have some changed it never effects the Embedded Contents.

## **Linking to an object-**

In Linking, when adding a media object adds a path to the original object, instead of embedding a copy of the object in the database. When the original document/object have some changed it directly effects the Linked Contents.
